## Clearance in last frame wins it

### Snooker

A magical 69 clearance in the last frame by Vinnie "Big Easy" Calabrese took him to victory in a thrilling final in the Kings Cup snooker championship in Dingley last weekend.

It was a sublime clearance under maximum pressure to win the tournament and the title in a single visit.

In the final, rising star Calabrese was pitted against the experienced Steve Mifsud.

The match started with a bang from Calabrese when he compiled a 50-plus break in the first frame in less than three minutes.

The second frame was a similar story and it looked as if Calabrese was about to run away with it.

But Mifsud had other ideas and he stopped the rot by winning the next two frames with a combination of exceptional long potting and pinpoint cue-ball control.

In the next frame Calabrese put together a quickfire break of 65 to get his nose in front again and lead 3-2, needing one more frame for the championship.

Yet again Mifsud came back, lev-

elling the best-of-seven-frames match at 3-3.

In the final frame Calabrese discarded caution. One risky shot let Mifsud in and he carefully built a commanding lead.

Leading 50-7, he made an rare error and his young opponent pounced, playing snooker of the highest order to take the frame, match and title. The "Big Easy"

made it look easy, and the crowd of over 100 gave the NSW player a hearty ovation.

Tournament High Break went to Rudy Sulaeman with a 109. The Kings Encouragement Award went to qualifier Steve Hanna (Liverpool, England).
